Wharton/Matagorda	El Campo ISD	El Campo ISD understands the hardships that COVID-19 is placing on our families. While we want to continue being proactive in helping reduce the spread of COVID-19, we also want to support our ECISD families by providing a free meal for the foreseeable future. Beginning Wednesday, March 18, 2020, to all children ages 0 - 18. Meals will be available for pickup at Northside Elementary (2610 Meadow Lane) by the cafeteria on Blossom Meyer. Pickup will be from 10:00 am - 11:00 am. District staff will deliver food to the vehicle; families will not need to exit the vehicle to receive the meals. Children MUST be present in the car to receive the meal.
	Wharton ISD	Wharton ISD will be offering, Grab-N-Go meals to all students 18 years or younger. Grab-N-Go lunches will be served from 10 am – 1 pm at the Wharton High School Cafeteria, Wednesday, March 18th through Friday, March 20, 2020. Parents and students will be able to pick up meals via a drive-through line outside the WHS Cafeteria in the student parking lot. Students must be present to receive a meal.
	Bay City ISD	Bay City ISD will be serving “to-go” meals at Linnie Roberts Elementary and Bay City Junior High from 10 AM till 12 noon, March 16-20th. Families are to drive up in the bus lane in their vehicles, and meals will be handed to them. One meal per student in the car will be distributed. So if there are four students in a specific vehicle, then four meals will be distributed to that car. We are encouraging folks to drive up, rather than walk-up, in order to encourage CDC recommendations regarding “social distancing.”
