

## Technology Waiver

Use of the Upbring School network is a privilege. You must read and agree to follow the network rules below to use our network account.

Upbring School makes available to student's access to the Internet. Devices are provided by the child's family.

Through the Internet students may have access to databases, Web sites, and sometimes email. Students might also publish online and participate in Zoom (type) classes. Students are expected to use computers and the Internet responsibly and for school related purposes only.

Use of the Upbring network is a privilege. Violations of conditions of use may result in that privilege being taken away in whole or in part by school personnel. Please review the closely related Student Code of Conduct.

As a condition of your right to use the Upbring School Internet service, you must understand and agree with the following:

### Use computing resources responsibly-

- use the Internet and any other computer resources for academic activities only.
- follow the guidelines for printing set by my teacher or school.
- will not transmit or deliberately access obscene, indecent, harassing, defamatory, or otherwise offensive material in any form.

### Use computing resources safely-

- will not give out my name, picture, address, e-mail, or any other personally identifying information online.
- will only access chat rooms, bulletin boards, blogs, Zoom (type) sessions, or post to an Internet site with explicit teacher permission.
- will not share my password with others.

### Use computing resources respectfully-

- will not deliberately attempt to harm or destroy data on any system on the network or internet.
- will not damage computer equipment or alter computer settings.
- will not use another student's device.

Understand that:

- students are responsible for what is done on personal computer (device).
- school personnel have the right to review any material sent, mailed, or accessed through

### The school provided network account-

- does not promise that the functions of the internet service will meet any specific requirements you may have, or that the Internet service will be error-free or uninterrupted.
- cannot be used to violate school policies, federal, or state laws.
- Campus administrators have the final say on what constitutes a violation of internet policies. (Violations include but are not limited to all bulleted points in this agreement.)
